To qualify for this rate you must actively support Mission Dolores School/Parish by: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. completing 30 School Service Hours <b>(15 of these hours must be accumulated by either helping with the annual Parish Festival and/or assisting with the Gym Snack Bar)</b></li> <li>2. participating in major school fundraisers (Fall Gift Wrap Sale, Spring Sale)</li> <li>3. participating in PTO (Parent Teacher Organization) events</li> <li>4. registering for E-Scrip by June 1, 2010 and maintaining your E-Scrip registration</li> </ol>	This is the full tuition based on the actual per pupil cost. Families who do not meet the criteria for ACTIVE SCHOOL FAMILIES will be charged these amounts.

**PAYMENT SCHEDULE**

Families have the option to divide the annual tuition cost into ten equal payments (August 2010 to May 2011) or twelve equal payments (August 2010 to July 2011). Families also have the option to receive monthly invoices from SMART (First Financial Services) or to have the tuition amount deducted directly from their accounts .

**TUITION ASSISTANCE**

We do have some funds available for tuition assistance. If the tuition rates do create great financial difficulties for your family, please contact us (861-7673). We will make every effort to assist our families to continue at Mission Dolores School.

**SERVICE HOURS**

This policy of participation and support requires each family to provide 30 hours of service. Fifteen of the 30 service hours must be completed at either the Parish/School Festival which takes place the weekend of October 8, 9, &10, 2010 or by volunteering in the gym snack bar. The Festival is our biggest fundraiser and profits subsidize the reduced tuition rate. The remaining hours can be served by attendance at PTO meetings assisting with the sports program, participating in various school and/or PTO activities, in addition to helping out at school. In addition to being a financial help to the school, the intent of the service hours is to involve parents in many aspects of school activities.
